OUTPATIENT SERVICES

To support each person's unique path to wellness, RHA offers group, individual, and family therapy, psychiatric care, medication management, peer support services, and more.



RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

RHA offers short-term and long-term residential services, including our Supported Living Program, Personal Care Homes, and Long-Term Structured Residences.

They encompass a range of support facilitated by mental health professionals, peer support specialists, and case managers. These programs emphasize personal growth, community, and a holistic approach to improving mental health.

PAHrtners Deaf Services offers disability services and supports to people who are Deaf and Hard of Hearing across PA in an environment free of cultural or language barriers.
