## HOST HOME SERVICES

In RHA's Host Home program, adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities have the option to live in the community in the private family home of Host Home professional caregivers.



## DAY & EMPLOYMENT SUPPORTS

Our day supports services focus on helping adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) set and reach personal goals, form and sustain meaningful community connections and relationships, achieve positive outcomes in health and wellness, and more.

We also offer an array of supported employment services, to help adults with IDD obtain competitive employment and provide the training and skills needed for them to work as independently as possible.
